Thorntons Distributes \$200,000 for Hunger Relief Efforts and Launches “Round Up” Program to Raise Additional Funds for Local Communities

(Louisville, KY – August 13, 2020) – Thorntons is proud to announce \$200,000 in donations to help feed the hungry in the communities where our Team Members and Guests live and work. Funds from the sale of a limited edition 24 oz. coffee have been distributed among 22 local hunger relief organizations.

Thorntons continues to engage Guests in raising funds for hunger relief through a new “Round Up” program. At the register, Guests are invited to round up their purchases to the nearest dollar for a donation to the store’s local hunger relief partner. As with the coffee proceeds, all funds raised in a community will stay in that community.

“Giving back to the communities where our Team Members and Guests live and work has always been a key part of who we are at Thorntons,” said Simon Richards, President and Chief Executive Officer. “We believe that all people should get the food they need to thrive and grow and we are proud to support these fantastic organizations that work tirelessly to feed the hungry in our communities. Thorntons is a long-standing food donation partner of Louisville-based Kentucky Harvest, having donated more than 1 million pounds of surplus food over the years.
